Keynote Speaker:

Amy E. Boutwell, MD, MPP



Dr. Boutwell is a graduate of Stanford University, Brown University School of Medicine and the Harvard Kennedy School of Government, where she received a master's degree in public policy and the Robert F. Kennedy Award for Excellence in Public Service. She is the founder of Collaborative Healthcare Strategies and currently the strategic and technical advisor

for the Massachusetts Health Policy Commission's \$120M CHART program. She is also an expert advisor to the New York State Medicaid DSRIP program's Super Utilizer collaborative.

The Role of Case Managers in Healthcare Transformation

Since the passage of the Affordable Care Act in 2010, Dr. Boutwell has advised communities, systems, regions, states and national groups seeking to improve healthcare quality through efforts focused on improving care over time and reducing the unnecessary use of the hospital setting. Drawing upon her experiences leading and advising efforts to improve care through the Institute for Healthcare Improvement, the CMS ACO Learning System, the CMS Bundled Payment Learning System, the AHRQ-funded Reducing Medicaid Readmissions Program, and several state-wide efforts to reduce readmissions, including DSRIP, Dr. Boutwell will describe the central role of case managers and the teams they work with in achieving measurable success in improving care and reducing costs.

Interactive Workshop

In this session, attendees will discuss the challenges and opportunities presented by the healthcare transformation efforts in New York, and identify opportunities to improve or adapt their current practices to help their organizations succeed in population based management. Areas of expected focus include: working with clearly defined measurable performance objectives, identifying patients who are "really" at high risk of readmission or high utilization, expected time frames for achieving impact with individuals and for the program, effective strategies for working with partners - hospitals, post-acute care providers, community based providers and agencies, effective strategies for patient engagement, specifically addressing "whole-person" needs and establishing a helpful, responsive, "non-medicalized" therapeutic relationship.
